<u>Text</u>: Acts 6:8-8:3

<u>Introduction</u>: We are continuing our series entitled "Here Am I, Send Me: The Acts of the Apostles." Tonight we are going to consider the heavy persecution against the early church and their response to it. Specifically, we are going to look at Stephen's death and about how we would deal with similar persecution.
