Text : **Psalm 60**

#### Introduction:

1. **Psalm 60** was written by King David as a “michtam” for teaching purposes.
2. Its a lot like the “Wise Man” song or the “Crayon” song.
3. It was written right after a low point in his life.
4. David had experienced some trials as commander and cheif.
5. The Israelites went to war against three of their enemies at the same time (Mesopotamia and Syria and Edom) and failed.
6. Joab, however, was successful because he killed 12,000 Edomites.
7. This psalm seems to be a community lament that was designed to remind the people of God’s providence.
