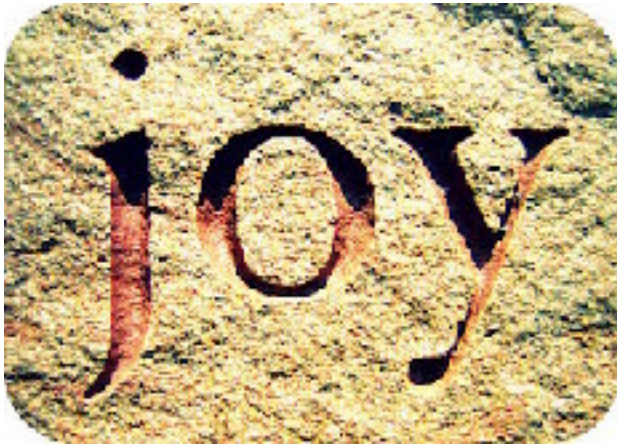


Paul's Reasons to Rejoice in Philippians
