

eXamining Godly Characters GULF SHORES CHURCH OF CHRIST

<u>Introduction</u>: We are living in an age when the Christian home is under attack. We are bombarded from every side and it is taking its toll on faithful Christians. We need to put the family first! In this specific lesson we will focus on examining godly characters. When we are looking for a pattern to follow it is wise to look to the Scriptures.
