A. When people box up God.

B. When people give their loyalty to other gods.

Matthew 6:33, Exodus 20:1-6

C. When people neglect to give God the glory.

Psalm 86:9, Psalm 86:12, Revelation 4:11

II. When Does The Glory Return?

A. When God's people mourn the glory will return.

I Samuel 7:2, Psalm 51:10

B. When God's people seek Him the glory will return.

I Samuel 7:3, Hebrews 11:6

C. When God's people put away foreign gods the glory will return.

I Samuel 7:3-4, Joshua 24:20

D. When God's people pray the glory will return.

I Samuel 7:5, II Chronicles 7:14

E. When God's people repent the glory will return.

I Samuel 7:5-6, Ezekiel 18:30

F. When God's people confess the glory will return.

I Samuel 7:6, Psalm 32:5

III. What Can I Learn About This Glory?

- A. God prepares for the glory.
- B. Satan attacks the glory.
- C. The church should pray for the glory.
