



The Faith of Enoch

Text: Hebrews 11:5-6



Introduction: Enoch was the seventh from Adam through Seth (Genesis 5:24, Jude 14) and is a part of that “godly” lineage of believers. The Bible also follows the story of the third from Adam through Cain, which is the “ungodly” line (Genesis 4:17). Let’s take a closer look at Enoch and see why we should build on his foundation of faith. . . .

Discussion:

I. Enoch Preached the Word of God

- A. He had a great message for the people of his time.
Jude 14-15, Genesis 6:5
- B. He has a great message for the people of our time.
Matthew 24:37-44, II Timothy 3:1-5, I Timothy 4:1, II Timothy 4:3

II. Enoch Walked With God

- A. Walking with God is a sign of surrender to God.
John 7:7, 15:19, Romans 12:1-2, Galatians 1:4, Ephesians 2:2, James 4:4, I John 5:19, Isaiah 53:6, 55:7, Romans 3:12
- B. Walking with God is a sign of reconciliation to God.
II Corinthians 5:20, Amos 3:3, Romans 12:1-2
- C. Walking with God is a sign of dedication to God.
Micah 6:8, Isaiah 57:15, Romans 10:17, II Corinthians 5:7
- D. Walking with God is a sign of living for God.
James 4:4, John 15:19, I John 2:15-16, I Peter 1:15-16; I Thessalonians 4:7

III. Enoch Was An Exemplary Man of God

- A. Enoch was a man of God with perseverance.
Genesis 6:5, Jude 14-15
- B. Enoch was a man of God with focus.
Psalm 23:3-4, 3:6, 27:1-4, 118:6, Isaiah 41:10, I Corinthians 15:55-57
- C. Enoch was a man of God with determination.
John 15:20, Acts 14:22, Philippians 1:29, Psalm 119
- D. Enoch was a man of God with purpose.
I John 1:7, II John 4, III John 4, Ephesians 5:8, Philippians 2:15, Ephesians 5:11

IV. Enoch Was Rewarded By God

- A. Enoch enjoyed fellowship with God.
Micah 6:8; Deuteronomy 10:12-13, I John 1:6-7
- B. Enoch pleased God.
Romans 6:23, 8:8, Ephesians 6:6; I Thessalonians 2:4, Galatians 1:10, Colossians 3:2, I Thessalonians 4:1, I John 3:22, Hebrews 13:6
- C. Enoch was taken into heaven.
Hebrews 11:5, Colossians 1:13, John 5:24, Colossians 3:1-3, Ephesians 2:6
- D. Enoch experienced life after death.
Hebrews 9:27, I Corinthians 15:51

Conclusion: Enoch walked with God like no other before him. He refused to walk an independent life and became totally dependent upon God. Do you have that kind of faith?
