III. LOVE IS REJECTING (vs.4-7)

*Love does not envy.
Love does not parade itself.
Love is not puffed up.
Love does not behave rudely.
Love does not seek its own.
Love is not provoked.
Love thinks no evil.
Love does not rejoice in iniquity.*

IV. LOVE IS MATURE (vs.8-11)

*Love never fails.
Love will outlast prophecies, tongues, and knowledge.
Love looks forward, never backward.
Love leads us away from child-like immaturity.
Love leads us on toward perfection.*

V. LOVE IS EVERLASTING (vs.12-13)

*Love will help us to see clearly.
Love will help us to see ourselves.
Love will help us to see others.
Love is to be compared to faith and hope.
Love is greatest human virtue.*
