- V. What did His aunts & uncles think about His birth?
 - □ Luke 1:5-25, Luke 1:39-80, Luke 2:44, John 1:6-8
- VI. What did His cousins think about His birth?
 - ⇒ Matthew 3:1-17, Mark 1:1-13, Luke 3:1-22, John 1:29-36
- VII. What did His siblings think about His birth?
 - ⇒ Matthew 12:47, 13:54-56, John 19:26-27, James, I Corinthians 15:7, Jude
