III. God Is Able to Work Without You

Working Without You Means A New Direction

Working Without You Means A Promise to Destroy & Build

Acts 20:32, Jeremiah 18, John 10, Romans 11:23, Romans 14:4, Hebrews 7:25, Isaiah 55:9, Jude 1:24

Conclusion: God is able to do "exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think" because His goal is to work in us and with us.
