Text: Proverbs 31:10-31

- VI. *Mother of Jesus - Mary (Luke 1:26-56, 2:49-52, John 2:1-11)*
- VII. *Mother of Timothy - Eunice (II Timothy 1:5, 3:14-15)*

Conclusion: Prayer may be the greatest way God can build an indestructible relationship with His children. Mothers, you may not see your name on the pages of this great book, but your story is written on our hearts. Your example is far more powerful than those inside the Bible because you are a living testimony to what God is doing for you and your family. Are you making His ways your ways?
