Conclusion: What do these stories have in common (Matthew 1:1-6)? All four of these women are in the story of Jesus: Tamar (v.3), Rahab (v.5), Ruth (v.5), Bathsheba (v.6). He would show mercy to sinners, show compassion to the harlots, and open His kingdom to the Gentiles. No matter what you've done in the past, Jesus can save you.
