Introduction: John describes Jesus as the Word of God, a Zealot, an Evangelist, a Provider, a Caretaker, a Shepherd, a Servant, and a Comforter. Now we see Jesus, the Teacher. Let's study together

Discussion:

I. Teaching About The Holy Spirit (16:1-16)

The Holy Spirit was coming to convict the world.

The Holy Spirit was coming to prepare the disciples for great trials.

The Holy Spirit was coming to teach the disciples.

The Holy Spirit was coming to glorify Christ.

II. Teaching About Jesus' Mission (16:17-33)

Jesus was sending the Holy Spirit to complete His mission.

Jesus wanted His disciples to enjoy many spiritual blessings.

The cross of Christ brought judgment to the world.

The Holy Spirit was given to the disciples for a significant purpose.

Christians should make every effort to understand the work of the Holy Spirit.

III. Teaching About Prayer (17:1-26)

Jesus prayed for His mission.

Jesus prayed for His disciples.

Jesus prayed for His church.

Jesus had unity in His mission, so He expected unity with His disciples and His church.

Conclusion: The gospel of John is profound, but simple. John clearly shows us that his intention is for the readers of this gospel to "believe" and "receive" the good news (**John 20:30-31**). Where are you in your walk with God? Do you believe Him and trust Him? Have you received salvation in His name?
