Introduction: Last time we studied together we noticed how beautiful the New Testament is knit together (the Gospels to the Revelation). We must remind ourselves that revelation is an unveiling of mysteries that were previously hidden from the saints. The book of Revelation is a rare behind-the-scenes part of the Bible that gives us a glimpse into heaven. Even though the audience and events of the book relate to the immediate audience, there is an underlying message that should grab our attention: Jesus is in control! What does that mean? Let's study together....
