

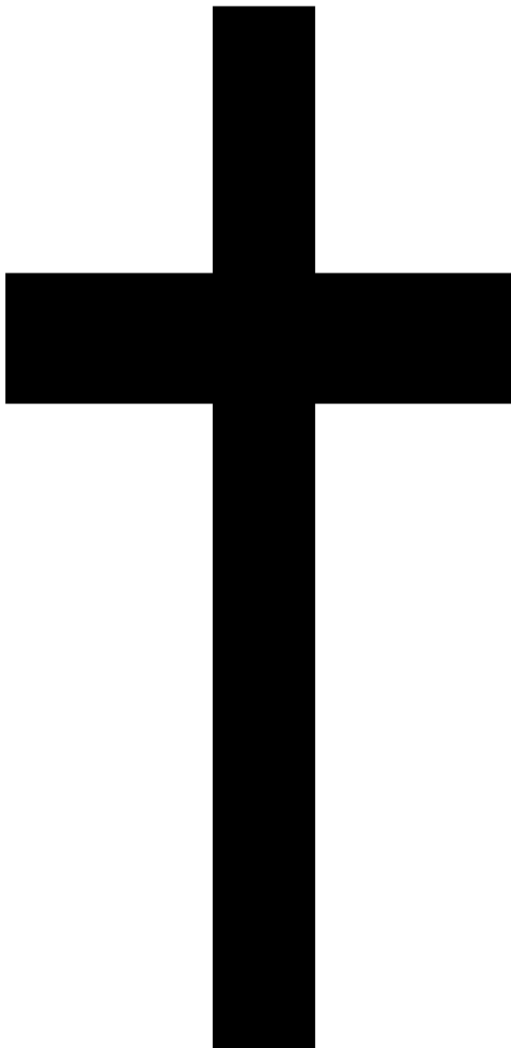
# ***Every Time I See The Cross***

Text: **Philippians 2:5-11**

Matthew 20:28, I Corinthians 6:19-20
- VII. Every Time I See The Cross, I See Victory***  
John 11:23-26, II Corinthians 15:51-58

Conclusion: Can you see these things? Can you see Jesus when you look at the cross? Can you see Him taking your place? What does the cross really mean to you? If you need to respond, Jesus is waiting at the foot of the cross . . . .
