Why Should We Study?

Introduction: Christianity is under attack. People are uneducated and unsure. What can we learn from **John 20:27, I Thessalonians 5:21, I Peter 3:15, I John 1:1-3**? We need to examine the evidence. Why would we choose to be ignorant? More evidence is needed! We need to carefully consider what God has said, what God has done, and embrace the facts. Where does the evidence lead us?

Discussion:

I. WHY DO WE NEED TO STUDY CHRISTIAN APOLOGETICS?

- A. **Jesus** wanted people to believe in Him based on the facts (**John 11:25-26, 12:24-26**).
- B. **Luke** was convinced that eyewitness testimony would aid our faith (**Luke 1:1-4, Acts 1:1-3**).
- C. **Paul** spent the latter part of his life explaining and proving that Jesus was the Messiah by defending the truth (**Acts 17:2-4**).
- D. **Peter** wanted Christians to “*always be ready to give a reason*” for our faith in Jesus with humility and respect (**I Peter 3:15**).
- E. **Jude** told believers to “*contend for the faith*” (**Jude 3**) when people challenged the truth.
