Materialism

<u>Introduction</u>: We are studying a series on TOXIC CHRISTIAN LIVING. We seek to recognize the things that happen when we DON'T give God our best. What gets in our way? What things can cripple our own spirituality along with those around us. We need to recognize these enemies and defeat them before they become toxic. Today we are going to talk about materialism. We have to realize that materialism sends us in the wrong direction (**Luke 12:15**). Let's study together...

- E. Materialism creates pitfalls (I John 5:19).
