LESSON #9: POINTED PRAYER

Boldly Approach The Throne

Text: Job 42:2-6

Introduction: As Christians, we are soldiers of the cross and warriors of the faith. We need to be equipped for the ministry and prepared for the battles of life. We are continuing our series on training to be prayer warriors. Tonight we are going to consider one of the most amazing, yet underappreciated prayers in the Bible. One uttered by Job. Let's study together...

- III. *Pointed Prayer Requires Blindness (Job 2:9)*
- IV. *Pointed Prayer Requires Dependence (Job 13:15)*
- V. *Pointed Prayer Requires Confidence (Job 40:8)*
- VI. *Pointed Prayer Requires Assurance (Job 40:15-24, 41:1-34)*
- VII. *Pointed Prayer Requires Endurance (Job 42:7-16)*

Conclusion: Prayer may be the greatest way God can build an indestructible relationship God with His children. Are you in a place where you find yourself questioning God? Do you feel He is blind to your circumstances? Are you frustrated that you suffer and God is not delivering you? Go ahead and argue your case, but remember Job's prayer. When all is said and done, give it to God. Surrender it at the foot of the cross. God is with you!
