Text: Daniel 6:1-28

Introduction: As Christians, we are soldiers of the cross and warriors of the faith. We need to be equipped for the ministry and prepared for the battles of life. IV. The Reverence in Persistent Prayer

Exodus 33:17-34:8, Isaiah 6:1-5, Revelation 1:10-17, Matthew 6:9, 13, Exodus 19:10-15

V. The Frequency of Persistent Prayer

Ezra 9:5, Psalms 55:17, I Thessalonians 5:17, Matthew 26:36-46, Mark 14:32-42,
Luke 22:39-46, II Corinthians 12:8

VI. The Innocence of Persistent Prayer

I Samuel 16:7, Matthew 26:36-46, Matthew 6:12-15, I Timothy 2:8, James 5:16, I Peter 4:12

VII. The Influence of Persistent Prayer

Matthew 7:7-12, James 5:13-16, Matthew 6:13, Daniel 3:25, Romans 8:26-34, Hebrews 9:24

Conclusion: Prayer may be the greatest way God can build an indestructible relationship with His children. When we feel covered up, washed out, watered down, swallowed whole and nearly strangled to death, God is there! Wait on the Lord!
