- VI. Option #6 = Discard The Unimportant Things

- VII. Option #7 = Send For Help

- VIII. Option #8 = Pray For Help

- IX. Option #9 = Search For A Lifeboat

- X. Option #10 = Do Whatever It Takes To Reach Safety
