<u>Introduction</u>: There are several fantastic stories in the Bible. Many of our favorites are the ones that reveal when a person is called by God or used for some special purpose. Personally, I love the conversions in the book of Acts. Let's consider one of those great stories together...

Discussion:

B = Believing in Jesus (vs.30,37)

A = Admitting Sin (vs. 32-33)

P = Proclaiming Christ (v.37)

T = Trusting the Message (vs.30, 35)

I = Immersion Into Christ (vs. 38-39)

S = Saving Souls (v.39)

M = Ministering to Others (v.40)

Conclusion: The Scriptures are silent in reference to what happened to this man who converted to Christianity. In his book Against the Heresies (180 AD), Irenaeus wrote, "This man (Simeon Bachos the Eunuch) was also sent into the regions of Ethiopia, to preach what he had himself believed, that there was one God preached by the prophets, but that the Son of this (God) had already made (His) appearance in human flesh, and had been led as a sheep to the slaughter; and all the other statements which the prophets made regarding Him." We can be confident that wherever he went, whatever he did, his life was forever changed. Have you obeyed the gospel? Are you sharing the good news?
