Introduction: We recently spent a great deal of time looking at the life and works of Jesus, but what about His name? There is something special about that name. How many songs in our hymn books lift up the name of Jesus? How many times do we mention His name throughout the day? Please open up your Bible and let's study together...

Conclusion: Please consider the name of Jesus. There is POWER in His name! Do you believe in Him? King David said, "*Some trust in chariots, and some in horses... but we will remember the name of the LORD our God*" (Psalms 20:7). He also said that our help is in "*the name of the Lord*" (Psalm 124:8). Will you surrender in the name of the Lord? Will you confess the name of the Lord?
