LESSON SEVENTEEN: Unveiling the Victory of the Lamb (19:11-20:15)

Introduction: The book of Revelation was written to the seven churches of Asia for immediate application. We are currently viewing the climax of the book. There is truly only one kingdom that can stand forever! The events described in this section of Revelation describe the last few scenes before the final curtain call. The hallelujah chorus has begun. The enemy has been slain. The wedding feast has been set. However, there is still time for a final victory lap before the last judgment. Let's study together...

II. The Defeat of the Enemy (19:17-21)

What prophecies are being fulfilled in this chapter?

What is the pre-millennial view? What is the difference between pre-tribunal, mid-tribunal, and post-tribunal?

What is the a-millennial view?

IV. Satan Is Temporarily Unbound (20:7-10)

How can we know that Satan will not succeed?

How can we know the gospel has power over Satan?

V. The Last Judgment Scene (20:11-15)

What is significant about this judgment scene?

What do we know about the thrones mentioned in Revelation?

Conclusion: We need to compare the scenes of Heaven and Hell in **Revelation 19-20**. Where would you choose to spend eternity? Have you taken steps to ensure your salvation? Have you heeded the warnings of the Lord? Are you ready to meet God? Are you ready for Jesus to come again? You can't sit this one out. You have to make a choice. Choose wisely!
