## Nehemiah: Answering the Call of God!!!

BUILDING BLOCK #5 = "Living"

TEXT: Nehemiah 5



<u>Introduction</u>: We can know the truth, and we can speak the truth, but all of that is useless unless we live the truth. If the Israelites did not speak the truth, and live the truth, they could not convert others to the truth. Nehemiah understood the importance of godly living. This was no time for hypocrisy. In this chapter, he outlines three motives for keeping your life clean.

<u>Conclusion</u>: As you can see, godly living is another very important building block for growth. Without it, the wall will come down as fast as it goes up.
