Text: II Kings 21-22 & II Chronicles 33-34

IV. The Fruit of Josiah's Revival

- A. Are in the same condition? What was their condition?
- B. God's Word is indestructible. (Matthew 24:35)
- C. God's Word is immutable. (II Timothy 3:16-17, Malachi 3:6)
- D. God's Word is irreversible. (**Revelation 22:18-19**)

<u>Conclusion</u>: C.S. Lewis once said, "It is Christ Himself, not the Bible, who is the true Word of God. The Bible, read in the right spirit and with the guidance of good teachers, will bring us to Him." Remember that we are not beyond the wrath of God (**Jeremiah 14:11**).
