III. They Exhorted With Praise (vs.12-21)

- A. Solomon thanked the Lord.
- B. Solomon encouraged the people.
- C. Solomon reflected on his father.

IV. They Edified In Prayer (vs.22-61)

- A. Solomon prayed an earnest prayer.
- B. Solomon prayed an appropriate prayer.
- C. Solomon prayed an obedient prayer.

V. They Engaged In Passionate Worship (vs.62-66)

- A. They offered their sacrifices.
- B. They worshipped for fourteen days.
- C. They didn't want to stop the worship and fellowship.
